**II. OLD BUSINESS:** Hippo Inventory Status and Phase I of Ground Floor await completion of Cookhouse. As noted by City Manager, Mechanical aspects of Orange Hall have been inspected, items noted including Duct work replacement and electrical panel replacement as part of MEP (Mechanical, Electrical and Plumbing) plan for building. Early Summer of 2024.
