July 1<sup>st</sup> 2024 begins the new Budget year. Expectations are City funds for Orange Hall will match 2023 level.

With the assistance of 32 volunteers who helped with food prep, distribution and cleanup, our Cookhouse Grand Opening on June 8<sup>th</sup> was a huge success! The St. Marys Community Band, Kiwanis Club and Kingsland Methodist Men exceeded all food preparation expectations. OHMC made a profit of \$1,603.00 which was promptly turned over to the City. Leftover food and drinks were loaded into the Salvation Army Disaster Relief Truck and distributed by Alise and Todd in several under-served areas of the city. Todd Harding, Vice-Chairman, is preparing a list of event issues to present to the City for resolution in future events.

OTHER ITEMS: Credit Card and Debit Card use will be considered for future events and possible means of donations to Orange Hall. Candace Pullum, DDA, will work with us to activate this important tool.
