18 **RESOLUTION TO OVERRIDE MAYOR VETO**

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20 Be it, and it is, hereby ordained by the Mayor Pro Tem and Council of the City of St. Marys, this
21 24th day of April, 2023:

23 WHEREAS, on April 17, 2023, the City Council unanimously approved a Resolution (referred to
24 hereinafter as "Bond Resolution"), which was more specifically entitled:

25
26 A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ST. MARYS, GEORGIA (THE
27 "CITY"), REQUESTING THE CAMDEN COUNTY PUBLIC SERVICE AUTHORITY (THE
28 "AUTHORITY") TO ISSUE ITS CAMDEN COUNTY PUBLIC SERVICE AUTHORITY REVENUE
29 BOND (CITY OF ST. MARYS PROJECT), SERIES 2023 IN THE PRINCIPAL AMOUNT NOT TO
30 EXCEED \$35,710,000 (THE "SERIES 2023 BOND"); TO AUTHORIZE THE EXECUTION AND
31 DELIVERY OF THE INTERGOVERNMENTAL CONTRACT (THE "CONTRACT") BETWEEN THE
32 CITY AND THE AUTHORITY; TO AUTHORIZE AND DIRECT THE PROPER OFFICERS AND
33 AGENTS OF THE CITY TO TAKE SUCH ACTIONS AS MAY BE NECESSARY IN CONNECTION
34 WITH THE ISSUANCE AND DELIVERY OF THE SERIES 2023 BOND; AND FOR OTHER
35 PURPOSES.

37 WHEREAS, the Bond Resolution was identified as New Item "D" on the agenda for the April 17,
38 2023 meeting, and was further described on said agenda as "TAX ALLOCATION DISTRICT NO. 2 (EXIT 1
39 PROJECT) REVENUE BOND RESOLUTION & INTERGOVERNMENTAL CONTRACT BETWEEN CAMDEN
40 COUNTY PUBLIC SERVICE AUTHORITY & CITY OF ST. MARYS";

42 WHEREAS, on April 20, 2023, the Mayor submitted to the City Clerk a written veto (referred to
43 hereinafter as the "Veto") of the Bond Resolution;

45 WHEREAS, Section 2-405 of the City Charter grants the City Council the power to override the
46 Veto by an affirmative vote of four of the six members of the council;

47

48 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council as follows:

49

50 Section 1. The City Council hereby exercises its power pursuant to Section 2-405 of the City Charter to
51 override the Mayor's Veto of the Bond Resolution.

52

53 Section 2. By virtue of this resolution overriding the Veto, the Bond Resolution shall be of full force and
54 effect as approved on April 17, 2023, and the Veto shall not be treated or interpreted as
55 having any effect on same.

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57 Section 3. Any and all ordinances and resolutions that are in conflict with this resolution are repealed.
